About The Guild

The non-profit Peninsula Glass Guild was established in 1986 to promote quality art glass in the community and to provide a forum for glass artists to gather together for educational and support purposes. Membership includes both professional and non-professional glass artists.

PGG offers workshops for members to encourage continual growth. Trips to see glass and related arts, meetings featuring guest lecturers, and the Annual Glass Show are a few of the membership benefits.

Each year, the Guild creates a large work in glass and donates it to a public location. This piece is funded by the Guild and donations, group designed, constructed, and installed by the Guild. Works are now displayed at the Newport News SPCA, the Virginia Living Museum, the Charles H. Taylor Arts Center, the Yorktown Victory Center, the Virginia Air and Space Center in Hampton, Shelton on the Bay in Phoebus, the Newport News Main Street Library, the Virginia Holocaust Museum in Richmond, and the American Theatre in Phoebus. The guild co-purchased a significant piece of glass for the Chrysler Museum in 1998.

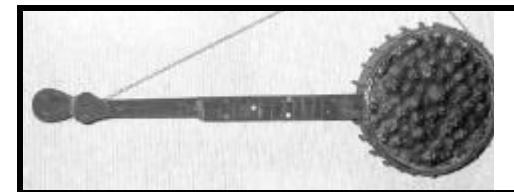
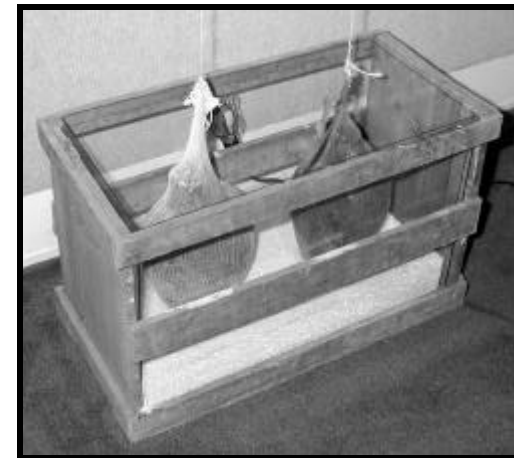

Elizabeth Perkins "Sow" won the Best in Show award last year and a solo show this year. Perkins was born and raised in a rural farming community. After earning a BFA in sculpture from the Atlanta College of Art and studying glass at the California College of Arts and Crafts, she returned to the Jamestown Glasshouse to study as an apprentice.

Statement: My work is the recollections and reinterpretations of memories formed at the family farm in Louisa County, Virginia. My work deals with southern mystique, family traditions and the stories that have been passed down from three generations of hardworking and loving "farming-folk". In my work, the material and subject matter preserve and show the deterioration of what is being forgotten and what has been worked so hard for. Fragility and strength are present in the work and speak as metaphor for what is handed down and what should or should not be passed on.



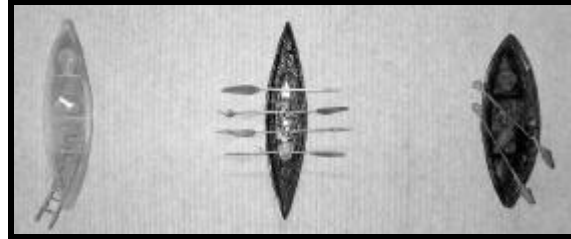
Rene Culler

This year's juror, Rene Culler has been an artist since 1973. In 1992 she received her BFA from the Cleveland Institute of Art.

In 1994 she received her MFA from Kent State University where she served as Acting Head of Glass for the school years 1998 to 2000. She continues to teach workshops at Urban Glass, Brooklyn, The Studio of the Corning Museum of Glass, the Cleveland Institute of Art, and the Fundacio Centre del vidre de Barcelona, Spain. Her kiln-transformed sculpture, Hot Blooded, is included in the permanent collection of the Renwick Gallery of the Smithsonian Institution.

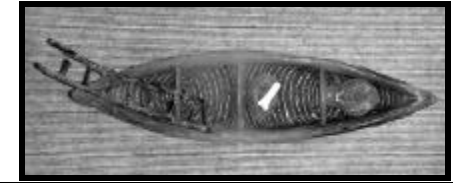
